3. The payment for your sins was paid in full. Romans 5:8: *“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”*

4. Believe in Christ’s death, burial, and resurrection and trust Him to save you from sin’s penalty. John

1:12: *“But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:”*

5. Call upon Him (in prayer) and God will answer. Romans 10:13: *“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”*

Please, repent (turn from sin) today and trust in Jesus alone, and God will grant you the gift of everlasting life. Then read your Bible daily and obey it.
