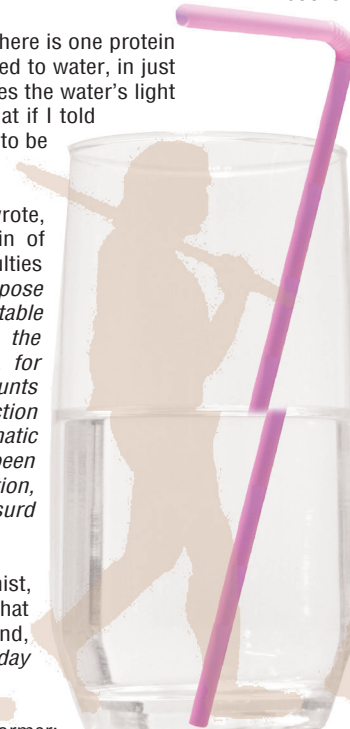
Professor Louis Bounoure, Former: President of the Biological Society of Strassbourg, and Director of the
